Mozilla Firefox

To access the pop-up blocker settings:

- 1. Click the menu button \equiv and select Options.
- 2. Select the Privacy & Security panel.
- Under the **Permissions** section, uncheck the box next to **Block pop-up windows** to disable the pop-up blocker altogether.
- A click on Exceptions... opens a dialog box with a list of sites that you want to allow to display pop-ups.
- The dialog box offers you the following choices:

Allow: Click this to add a website to the exceptions list.

Remove Website: Click this to remove a website from the exceptions list.

Opera



Opera will try to distinguish pop-ups that you have requested (login pages, for example) from pop-ups launched automatically from websites, such as advertising. By default, Opera will block pop-ups you have not requested. You can control how Opera handles pop-ups. To change pop-up settings:

- 1. Open Opera
- 2. Click the menu button in the top left hand corner
- 3. Go to Settings.
- 4. Click Advanced in the left sidebar, and click Privacy & security.
- 5. Under Privacy and security, click Site settings.
- 6. Click **Pop-ups and redirects**.
- 7. At the top, turn on or off **Allowed**.

Click the Add button to set site-specific preferences.

Safari



To disable the pop-up blocker on an OSX computer:

- 1. Click Safari on the top menu bar (to the right of the Apple icon)
- 2. Click 'Preferences'
- 3. Select the 'Security' tab
- 4. Turn off 'Block pop-ups'

To disable the pop-up blocker on a Windows computer:

- 1. Select the **Tools** button (the Cog icon found on the top right of your browser)
- 2. Click the 'Block Pop-Up Windows' option (so there is no longer a tick next to it)

Safari (Mobile)

Safari 5 and older

- 1. Click the "Safari" menu
- 2. Select the "Un-Block Pop-Up Windows"

Safari 6 and newer

- 1. Click the "Safari" menu
- 2. Select the "Preferences" option
- 3. Select *"Security"* from the top row of the preferences
- 4. Uncheck the "Block pop-up windows" box





Safari (Mobile-iPad)

Safari on iPads

- 5. Click the "Settings" menu
- 6. Select "Safari" under the "Settings" column
- 7. Turn the "Block Pop-ups" to the "off" setting

If pop-ups have been blocked, you'll see the blocked icon in the address bar.

To disable pop-ups:

- 1. Open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click More \therefore Settings.
- 3. At the bottom, click **Advanced**.
- 4. Under "Privacy and security," click **Site settings**.
- 5. Click **Pop-ups and redirects**.
- 6. At the top, turn the setting to **Allowed** or **Blocked**.

To allow pop-ups from a specific site:

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. Go to a page where pop-ups are blocked.
- 3. In the address bar, click Pop-up blocked.
- 4. Click the link for the pop-up you want to see.
- 5. To always see pop-ups for the site, select Always allow pop-ups and redirects from [site] > Done.

The site will be added to the exceptions list, which you can manage in the Content Settings dialog.

Internet Explorer



To disable the pop-up blocker:

- 1. Select the **Tools** button (the Cog icon in the top right of your browser screen)
- 2. Select Internet options
- 3. Select the **Privacy** tab
- 4. Un-tick the **Turn on Pop-Up Blocker** box
- 5. Select Apply
- 6. Select **OK** to close the window

Microsoft Edge



- In the new Microsoft Edge, go to Settings and more... > Settings > Site permissions.
- Select **Pop-ups and redirects**.
- Move the **Block** toggle to **On**.
